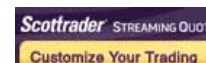

Joyent, a San Francisco-based provider of cloud computing software and services, has raised \$85 million in new VC funding. **Weather Investment II** led the round, and was joined by Telefonica Digital and return backers El Dorado Ventures, Epic Ventures, Greycroft Partners, Intel Capital, and Liberty Global. Mykonos Software Inc., a San Francisco-based provider of web security software, has raised \$4 million in Series A funding, according to VentureWire. Backers include Tom Golisano (Paychex), Jeff Clarke (Orbitz) and Mike Jones (Federated Clover Investment Advisors). www.mykonossoftware.com
